Devang Patel graduated in 2004 and has been working as a general dental practitioner since he graduated. During his professional career, Devang has developed a great interest in aesthetic and restorative dentistry, including implant dentistry. He has worked towards achieving the highest standards of dentistry by undertaking different postgraduate courses, including a one-year full-time MSc course at Eastman Dental Institute, for which he was awarded distinction and a postgraduate prize for excellence in clinical and academic achievement.

He has a special interest in patients with severe tooth surface loss, complex fixed prosthodontics using implants which may need autogenous bone-grafting and sinus lift procedure, full mouth rehabilitation and temporomandibular joint dysfunction.

In addition to private practice, Dr Patel teaches postgraduate dentists at University College London, Eastman Dental Institute, and many other institutes. He trains dentists who want to further their careers in restorative dentistry and mentors dentists for complex rehabilitation cases. His main teaching interests are occlusion and its use in full mouth reconstructions, including implant-supported restorations.

Devang is the author of two books; *Full Mouth Reconstruction for GDPs* and *Restoring Dental Implants for GDPs*.
