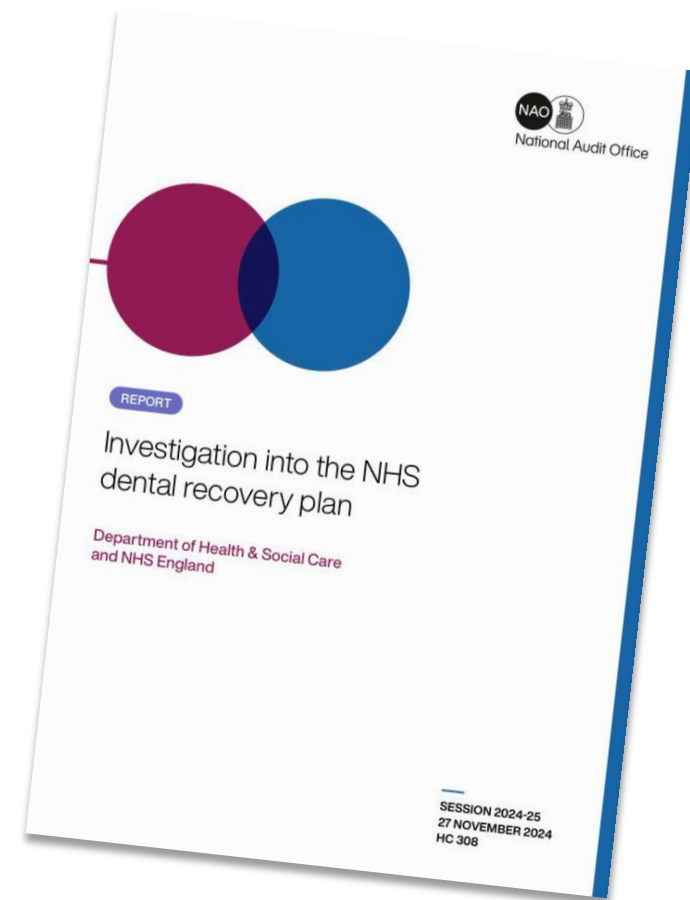
Real barriers remain

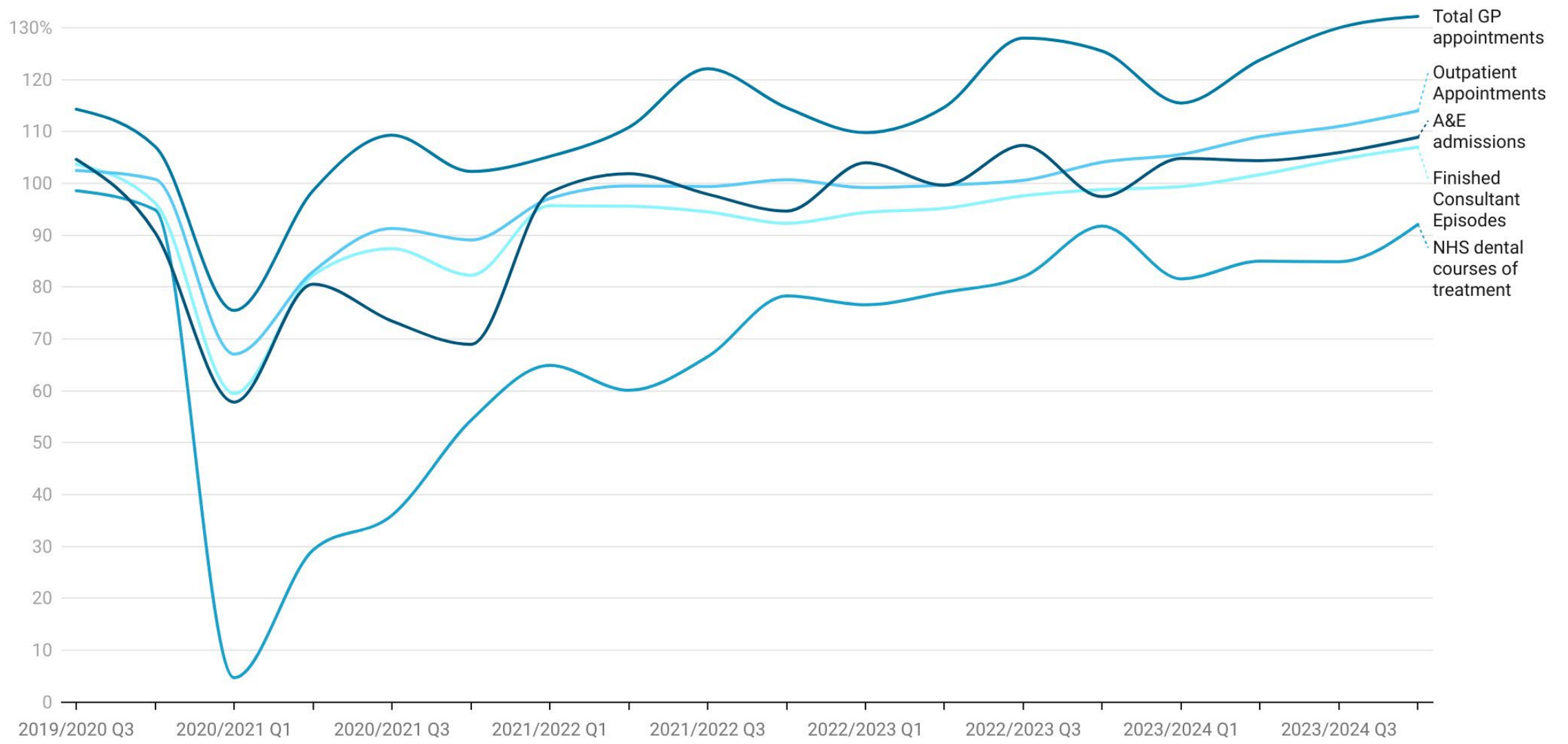
- No progress on 700,000 urgent appointments pledge.
