Title: Oral health for the vulnerable older person – Are we prepared?

Aim

This lecture aims to provide the audience with an improved understanding of the management of the oral health needs of the ageing population. Many older people will be increasingly vulnerable due to increasing cognitive, medical and physical disabilities that impact significantly on oral health and dental care needs.

- Discuss the more common medical conditions and the impact of frailty on the older population and the impact on dental care

- Discuss treatment planning for the older vulnerable, considering medical, social and cognitive changes.
