Level 1 - Thursday 31 October

Aims

This course will give an overview of current requirements and guidelines for CBCT, designed for clinicians who have attended an IRMER course within the past five years.

- Explain CBCT imaging selection criteria
- Recognise normal anatomy and common imaging artifacts
- Understand legal and ethical responsibilities as referrer, practitioner and operator.
